Transportation Rules

(Must be reveiwed with child)

- 1. Parent must indicate with a definitive "Yes" or "No" on the clipboard indicating pick up from school for each day of the week.
- 2. Parents must notify the Center of any schedule changes regarding pick up of his/ her child. In order to prevent miscommunication, please advise the Center by 3 PM of any changes.
- 3. Each driver has a radio (walkie talkie) that connects them to the other Center bus and the office.
- 4. The bus will leave the Center and schools at scheduled times. If your child is late arriving at the Center or has to remain after school, the Center cannot be responsible for their transportation.
- 5. If a child has a behavior problem on the bus, the parents will be given a warning letter. If a child receives three warnings during a semester, then they will not be allowed to ride for the remainder of the semester.

Children Expectations & Information

- 1. Everyone must be properly belted in at all times.
- 2. No horseplay or misbehavior will be tolerated.
- 3. No eating or chewing gum allowed on the bus.
- 4. If you miss the bus after school DO NOT walk to the Center or accept a ride from someone. Instead go back into the school and have the office call the Center and we will return for you.
- 5. If you are continually late to the bus, you will be given a warning and your parents notified. If it continues to be a problem, then you will need to find other transportation for an amount of time to be determined.
